Rationale

By virtue of their mandate through the Bishop, the Catholic Independent Schools, Diocese of Victoria are committed to providing, to their best of their ability, education to those who seek it.

Policy

International students who are Catholic or non-Catholic may be admitted to a Diocesan school provided that a school has sufficient facilities and resources and provided that fees for the program are paid upon registration.

Regulation

1. The Principal is responsible for approval of admission of international students to the school.
2. The Principal, or his/her designate, is to ensure that copies of either a passport and/or student study permit be kept in the student's file, and that the admission process conform to the requirements of Immigration Canada.
3. The parents of international students are required to acknowledge and understand that their children will participate in religious courses and celebrations which necessarily constitute a fundamental part of a Catholic school.
4. All regulations obtaining to admission and entrance requirements in Section 500 apply.
5. Tuition fees for international students will be set annually by the Board of Directors for approval each year.
